- Develop a ratio of total licensed taxi cabs in relation to the population;
- Develop a ratio of the number of accessible taxi cabs to the total number of taxi cabs licensed;
- Develop an incentive program to encourage the licensing of accessible taxi cabs;
- Is in keeping with the Integrated Accessibility Standards – Transportation Section

The Committee would really like to see licensed accessible taxi cab(s) within the Town of Caledon (similar to our neighbouring municipalities), as currently there is not one.
