WOODLAND PERMIT APPLICATIONS

The intent of Town of Caledon Woodlands By-law 2000-100, as amended, is to protect Caledon's woodlands and to promote the use of good forestry practices to improve the health and long term sustainability of local woodlands.

Selling Your Trees

Selling the harvest rights to your timber is a complex process and one that may only occur once or twice in your lifetime. In order to harvest in a sustainable manner and maximize your return, you would be well advised to consult a professional forester to develop a long term forest management plan for your woodland. Visit www.extranet.mnr.gov.on.ca/mftip/form/mfpa.cfm to find a contact list of some of the foresters working in Peel.

If you are or have been approached by a log buyer, recognize that your trees have value. Proceed with caution and exercise your due diligence before signing any contracts.

Application to Destroy Trees

Every application shall be accompanied with the following:

1. A site plan indicating the location of:
 - property and woodland
 - harvest area
 - landing and skid trails
 - stick nests (raptors)
2. Appropriate fee based on the Town of Caledon Fees By-law
3. Additional specifications, documents, and other information may be required.

It is highly recommended that you first contact the By-law Enforcement Section (905) 584-2272 and discuss any proposed work.

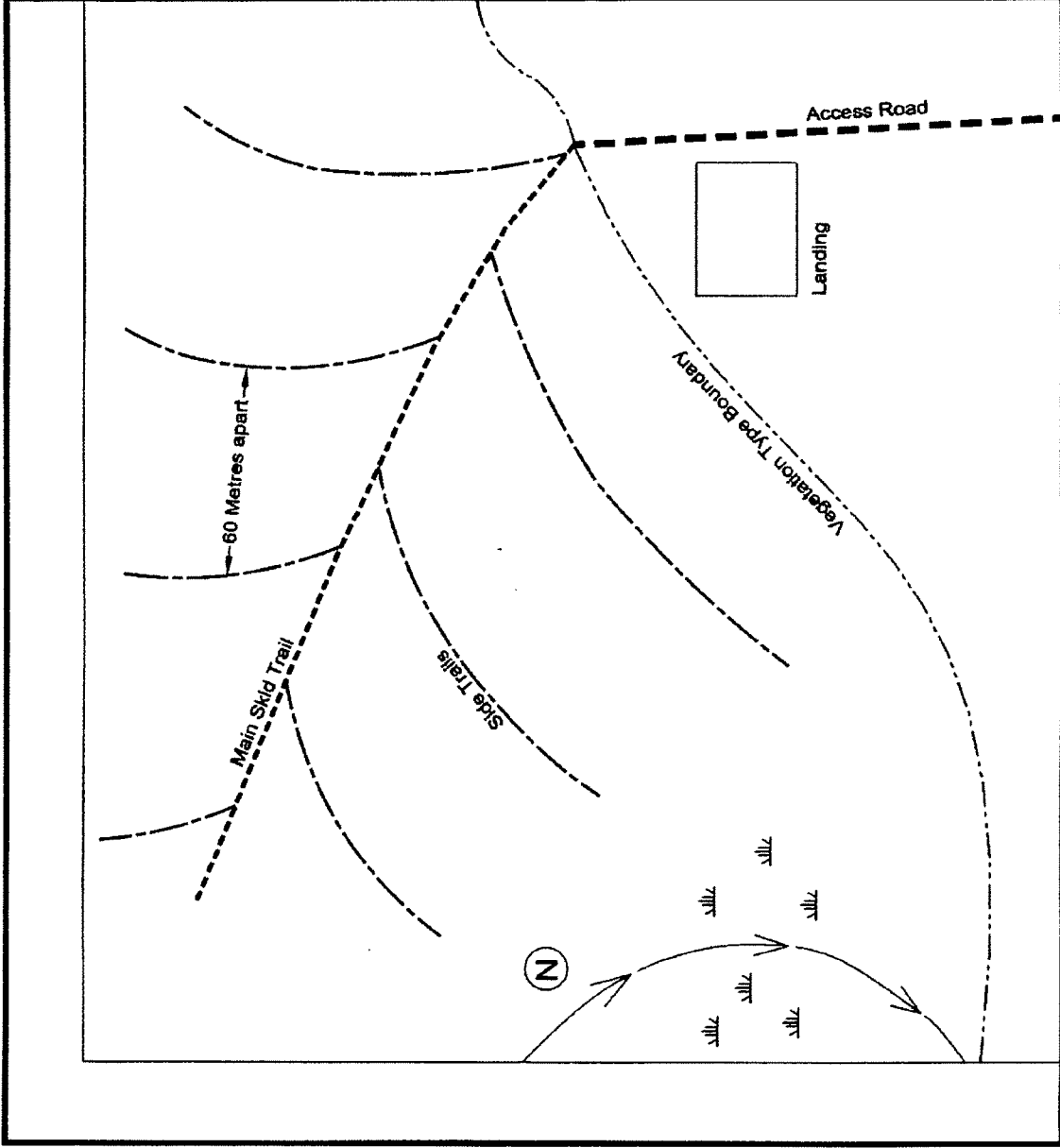

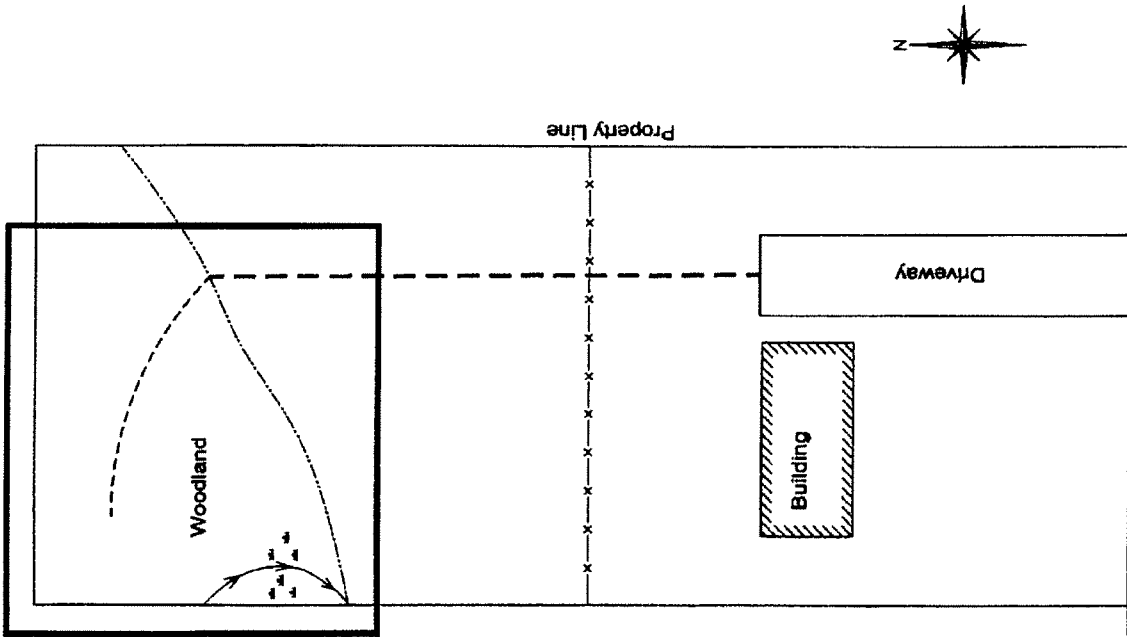

1. The contents of this application are subject to the provisions of Woodlands By-law 2000-100 (as amended) for the Town of Caledon.
2. Applications for tree destruction must be made by the property owner. The application may be signed by a representative for the property owner providing a letter of consent is received.
3. Fee as per Town of Caledon Fees By-law. All fees are non-refundable.
4. All work to be done in accordance with Woodlands By-Law 2000-100 (as amended) and any other applicable law.
5. Permits are valid for six months from date of issue. After a woodlands permit has expired, a new application must be submitted.
6. Any false or misleading statement made on this application will render null and void any permission granted.
7. Approval of this application does not exempt you from other approvals required by other agencies (i.e. Region of Peel).
8. The applicant agrees to allow Town staff or their agents to enter upon the lands to inspect and complete certain works at the applicant's expense, if necessary.
