2009 TREE SEEDLING PROGRAM

The Town of Caledon, in association with the Halton/Peel Woodlands and Wildlife Stewardship, is pleased to offer a native tree/shrub seedling program to landowners interested in reforesting their properties. The purpose of the program is to promote and encourage private reforestation efforts by making affordable native nursery stock accessible to local residents. This program is directed toward residents who own 0.5 hectares (1.2 acres) or greater of land.

A minimum order of 50 conifer seedlings and/or 5 deciduous trees or 10 shrubs is required. Unfortunately, we are unable to accept applications that do not meet these requirements. Stock is supplied on a first-come basis. Residents interested in obtaining trees are encouraged to submit orders and appropriate payment as quickly as possible. Taxes are included in cost. **All nursery stock is dormant bare root material from local seed zone 34.**

The following native species listed below are available to order for pick-up between 8AM -12PM on **Saturday April 18, 2009**. Please note you are responsible for your tree order. If you are unable to pick up your trees at this time, please make alternative arrangements or risk forfeiture of the order.
