

2011 TREE SEEDLING PROGRAM

The Town of Caledon, in association with the Halton/Peel Woodlands and Wildlife Stewardship, is pleased to offer a native tree/shrub seedling program to landowners interested in planting native plant species on their properties. The purpose of the program is to promote and encourage private reforestation/restoration efforts by making affordable native nursery stock accessible to local residents. This program is open to all Caledon landowners but geared to those who have a minimum 0.5 hectare of land.

A minimum order of seedlings/trees/shrubs as specified in the table below is required. Unfortunately, we are unable to accept applications that do not meet these requirements. Stock is supplied on a first-come, first-served basis. Residents interested in obtaining trees are encouraged to submit orders and appropriate payment as quickly as possible. Taxes are included in cost. All nursery stock is dormant bare root material from local tree seed zone 34.
