



Community Meeting Notice Employment Land Needs Study

The Town of Caledon is undertaking an Employment Land Needs Study to review its Official Plan designations and policies related to employment land. This study is part of the South Albion-Bolton Community Plan which was introduced to the public at a Community Meeting in June, 2005. The Employment Land Needs Study consists of three tasks: the determination of the future need for employment land; the designation of a new employment area in South Albion; and the review of the Official Plan policies regarding employment land to bring them into conformity with Provincial policies.

The study to determine the need for employment land has been completed in draft form by the Town's consultant, Watson & Associates Economists Ltd. This study identifies the need for employment land in South Albion – Bolton, Mayfield West, Tullamore and the remaining Rural Area.

The purpose of this Community Meeting is to present the draft Employment Land Needs Study for discussion and comment by residents and stakeholders. Following the Community Meeting, the consultants will review the input received from the public and finalize the report for presentation to Council.

This report will provide a basis for undertaking future studies to identify a new employment area in South Albion.
