#### 1. Conformity to the following Legislation, Policies, and Guidelines:

- b) 2005 Greenbelt Plan
- c) 2006 Growth Plan for the Greater Golden Horseshoe
- d) Region of Peel Official Plan.
- e) Town of Caledon Official Plan.
- f) Provincial, Regional & Town Growth Forecasts.
- g) Credit Valley Conservation Authority Studies/Policies

#### 2. Adherence to Draft Planning Objectives.

- a) Preserves/enhances character of Alton
- b) Protects cultural/archaeological resources
- c) Strengthens trail system.
- d) Enhances natural environment.
- e) Improves viability of the Core.
- f) Ensures pedestrian connectivity.
- g) Addresses parking deficiencies.
- h) Enhances new and existing streetscapes.
- i) Appropriate distribution of facilities/services.
- j) Appropriate population growth.
- k) Offers a range of compatible housing types.
- l) Appropriate phasing/timing of growth.

#### 3. Adherence to Draft Environmental Objectives.

- a) Assimilative capacity of the Credit River is not exceeded.
- b) No negative impacts on groundwater/water resources.
- c) Enhances natural environment.
- d) Promotes stewardship of natural environment.
- e) Protects/restores/enhances native species, biodiversity and productivity.
- f) Maintains/protects groundwater recharge and improve quality.
- g) Preserves/restores natural hydrological cycle.
- h) Minimizes risk due to flooding.
- i) Maintains water quality for ecological purposes.
