1996			July 1996: Region of Peel Official Plan adopted by Regional Council. Plan sets out policy framework for the Town and Region to jointly undertake the Caledon Community Resource Study (CCRS) to develop detailed local aggregate resource management policies. A number of appeals to the Regional Official Plan were received.	Fall 1996 to Early 2000: Completion of the CCRS and development of detailed local aggregate resource management policies.

1998	February 1998: Appeals to the Region of Peel Official Plan related to aggregates/environmental policies resolved by settlement agreement amongst all parties. Related sections of the Regional Official Plan approved by the Ontario Municipal Board.	March 1998: James Dick Construction Limited applies to the Town of Caledon for an Official Plan Amendment and Rezoning and to the Ministry of Natural Resources for a license to quarry below water table, to permit the Rockfort Quarry.

2000		March 2000: Based on the work of the CCRS and the subsequent policy development process, the Town adopts new aggregate resource management policies through Official Plan Amendment 161 (OPA 161). Thirteen objections to OPA 161 were received.	June to September 2000: Rockfort Quarry applications (Official Plan Amendment, Rezoning and Aggregate License) referred to the Ontario Municipal Board.	
2001	2001 to mid-2003: Ongoing discussions between all parties resulted in all objections to OPA 161 being settled and the amendment was approved by the Ontario Municipal Board in May 2003. The status of Aggregate Resource Area 9-A (which includes the Rockfort Quarry Lands) is deferred.

2003				November 2003: Ontario Municipal Board rules that OPA 161 applies to the Rockfort Quarry application, and that the application is to be revised to address the requirements of OPA 161. OPA 161 contains the policies requiring a Comprehensive Broader Scale Environmental Study (CBSES) for Aggregate "Reserve" lands. Despite the deferred status of Resource Area 9-A, James Dick Construction Limited agrees to begin preparing a CBSES.
2004	January 2004 to August 2007: Preparation of CBSES begins in January 2004. Anticipated completion date is August 2007 in accordance with timelines approved by the Ontario Municipal Board
