Kennedy Road Improvements Class Environmental Assessment (from Highway 410 to the northern limit of the Mayfield West Community Development Plan Area)

The Town of Caledon is undertaking a Class Environmental Assessment to investigate various improvements to Kennedy Road from Highway 410 to the northern limit of the Mayfield West Community Development Plan Area, a distance of approximately 1.7 km. Improvements to Kennedy Road are necessary to meet the projected increase in traffic demand and urban design objectives as a result of development of the Mayfield West Community Development Plan Area. Entra Consultants is conducting the study for the Town of Caledon.

A second Public Information Centre (PIC) is planned to present the preliminary recommended design to the public and interested stakeholders. The second PIC is to be held as follows:

When the study commenced, it was being conducted in compliance with the "integrated approach" as set out in Section A.2.9 of the Municipal Engineers Association's "Municipal Class Environmental Assessment" (June 2000). Accordingly, improvements to Kennedy Road would have been planned and assessed to meet the requirements of both the Environmental Assessment Act and Planning Act, but approved under the Planning Act, through the approval of a plan of subdivision. However, the land use planning process has been delayed because the Mayfield West Community Development Plan has been appealed to the Ontario Municipal Board. Because of time constraints associated with the implementation of planned Regional infrastructure projects, the study is now being conducted in compliance with the provisions for Schedule "C" type projects of the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment.

At the end of the study, an Environmental Study Report (ESR) will be completed which will document the entire planning process undertaken for the project and will be placed on the public record for a period of 30 calendar days. At this point a notice of Completion of the Environmental Study Report will be issued to advise the public where the ESR may be seen and reviewed and the manner in which public comment can be submitted.

To date, planning alternatives have been considered and a preferred planning alternative was presented at the first Public Information Centre on May 23, 2006. The study team is now considering, evaluating and detailing alternative design concepts for the preferred planning alternative for Kennedy Road.

Those attending the PIC will have the opportunity to meet with the Project Team, review the study scope, and discuss issues related to the project including the selection and evaluation of alternative designs, environmental considerations and avoidance and mitigation of potential impacts.
