Background Info

➤ Town of Caledon

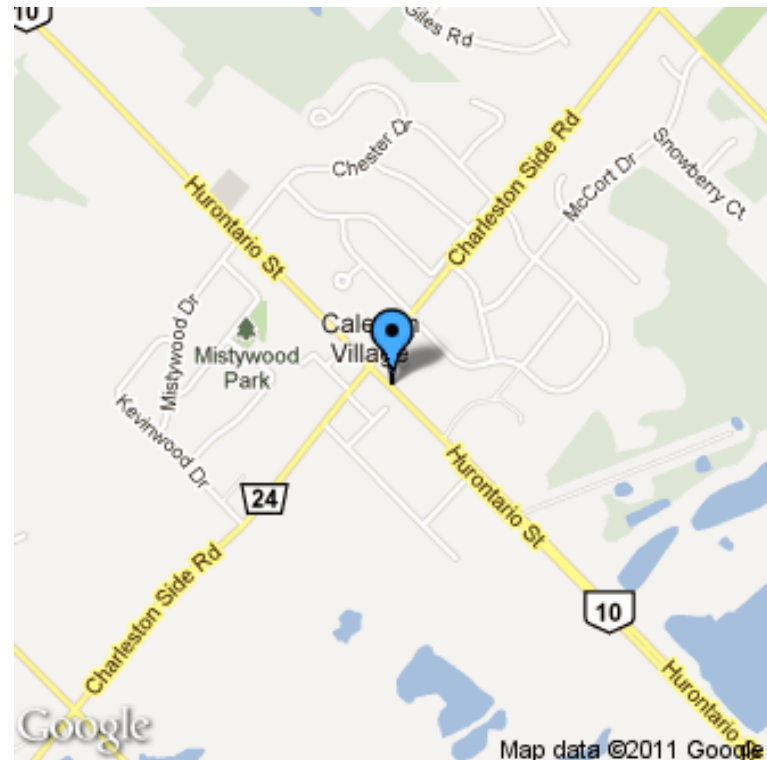
- 1 of 3 municipalities within Peel
- Geographically the largest of the three municipalities
- Primarily rural, with some urban concentrations (e.g. Bolton)



Background Info Cont'd

➤ Caledon Village

- 1 of 6 designated Villages within the Town of Caledon
- Home to approximately 1,500 – 2,000 people
- Main intersection is Charleston Side Road & Highway 10



Background Information

- In 2009, Highway 10 expanded to 4 lanes by MTO
- MTO advised Town to prepare vision/plan for Caledon Village

Ryerson University

- The Town of Caledon has partnered with Ryerson University to prepare Visioning Exercise
- Studying existing conditions, research similar communities, conduct workshops, and prepare long-term vision with recommendations
- The vision should be a combination of community input and good planning principles in order to be the basis for future plans

The “4 Phase Process”

- Phase 1: Background Study
 - Existing conditions
 - Provincial, regional, and local policies
 - Opportunities and constraints



The “4 Phase Process” Cont’d

- Phase 2: Community Input
 - Residents’ perspective
 - Caledon Village needs/wants
 - Workshop



The “4 Phase Process” Cont’d

- Phase 3: Visioning Process
 - Combine community’s input, research, and expertise
 - Guiding principles, goal statements, and concrete examples
 - Present to community and revise vision



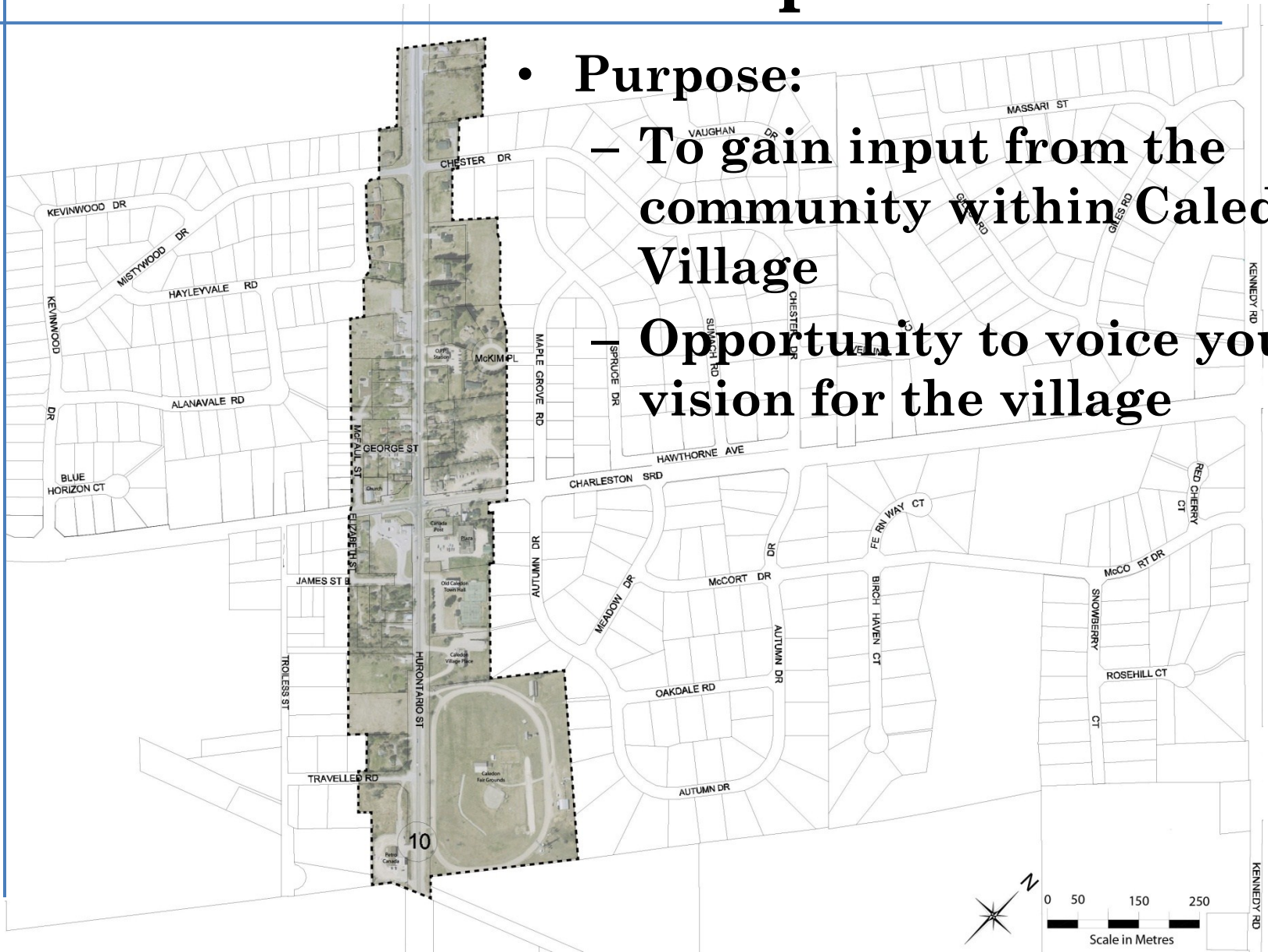
The “4 Phase Process” Cont’d

- Phase 4: Implementation
 - Suggest next steps Town of Caledon to take
 - Options available to implement Vision and create plans



Outline of Workshop

- Purpose:
 - To gain input from the community within Caledon Village
 - Opportunity to voice your vision for the village



Outline of Workshop Cont'd

- Outline
 - Break up into smaller groups
 - Maps, images, and markers provided
 - Students will guide separate group discussions
 - Ideas, feelings, suggestions, etc. will be recorded
 - Information will form the foundation for the vision

Outline of Workshop Cont'd

- Strategy
 - Within the smaller groups you may discuss and illustrate your vision of Caledon Village on the maps provided
 - Use the following questions to guide your discussion:
 - Where and what are the opportunities?
 - Where do you want things to happen?
 - What do you see for the future of Caledon Village?
 - What is your vision for Caledon Village?
 - Student facilitators will record main points of conversation and provide more detailed questions to drive conversation
