Re: Decorative Stones and Curbing

Please be advised that all decorative stones, curbing etc., constructed on the boulevard are to be moved by the owner, at least four feet from the curb or roadside by November 10, 2008 to facilitate snow plowing, snow removal, or snow blowing.


Where sidewalks are cleared by the Town owned or hired equipment, all decorative stones, curbing etc. shall be moved at least one foot back from the edge of the sidewalk to allow the equipment to complete the snow clearing operations.

The Town of Caledon does not accept any liability for damage to decorative stones, curbing or similar installation that encroach onto Town property. The Town of Caledon will consider the property owner liable to the Town where the unauthorized installation of decorative stones, curbing and similar objects causes damage to Town owned or Town hired equipment working on the sidewalk.

If the curbing is permanent, please visibly mark it to warn the operator. This will help to minimize damage to your curbing and our equipment.
