

Coleraine Drive Widening and Reconstruction

The Coleraine Drive widening and reconstruction project includes the following key components:

- Road widening from 2 to 4 lanes;
- Realignment and signalization of the intersection of Mayfield Road and Coleraine Drive
- Signalized intersections along Coleraine Drive at Healey Road, Ellwood Drive and King Street/Harvest Moon Drive;
- CN Railways grade crossing improvements including crossing guards which are integrated with the proposed signals at Coleraine Drive and Ellwood Drive; and
- Relocation of existing Hydro lines, Bell and Rogers line and Enbridge Consumers Gas Pipeline.

These road works are being carried out in accordance with the approved Bolton Arterial Roads Individual Environmental Assessment. The widening and reconstruction of Coleraine Drive will take place in two stages as follows:

STAGE 1:

Widening and reconstruction of Coleraine Drive from 300m south of Mayfield Road to 650 m south of Healey Road, including 250m of Mayfield Road east and west of Coleraine Drive. Construction is anticipated to start the first week of August 2007.

STAGE 2:

Widening and reconstruction of Coleraine Drive from 650m south of Healey Road to 250m north of King Street, including 250m of Healey Road east and west of Coleraine Drive and the realignment of King Street to intersect with Coleraine Drive at Harvest Moon Road. The construction of Stage 2 is anticipated to start in the in the Spring of 2008.
