The Region of Peel is conducting a Class Environmental Assessment (EA) for the construction of a new elevated tank and feedermain to provide water storage for pressure stabilization firefighting and emergency storage for existing and approved planned growth in the north service area of Bolton.

A representative from the Town of Caledon Public Works Department will also be in attendance to update the Public on the reconstruction of Ann Street, including Phase 2 of the Bolton West downtown parking lot and the southwest Humber River parkette.
