HOME SAFE HOME – CALEDON'S DOOR-TO-DOOR SAFETY AWARENESS CAMPAIGN

Don't be alarmed if you see fire crews pull up outside of your home and a firefighter approaching your door!

Chances are there isn't a fire in your home, but rather firefighters' spreading the word on how to ensure one never develops.

Starting May 25 and running until September 30, Caledon Firefighters will be going door-to-door between the hours of 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. to homes throughout the Bolton community.

The program is aimed to provide residents with valuable fire safety information and bring awareness to residents that legislation requires working smoke alarms on all levels of their home. Fire safety information will be distributed to each household along with the opportunity for each homeowner to ask questions.

The Town of Caledon supports the principle of 'prevention rather than cure.' It is through this proactive approach to the prevention, detection and escape, that the risk to the community is effectively managed.
