The Study

In response to continued population growth and increased wear and tear on existing infrastructure through increased traffic, development, new infrastructure, and increased expectations as to the type and quality of services the Town provides, the Town of Caledon has identified the need for improvements to Glasgow Road, from Chickadee Lane to Deer Valley Drive. Subsequently, the Town has initiated a Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (Class EA) to review and identify required road improvements along the corridor. Within the study limits, Glasgow Road will retain the existing two-lane configuration, however various options will be evaluated to enhance safety, improve traffic operations and to better accommodate road users of all types.



The Process

The purpose of the study is to identify recommended designs for Glasgow Road that address the increasing wear and tear associated with population growth while enhancing road safety, improving traffic operations and connectivity for all users. In identifying the road improvements, the study will consider the technical and aesthetic requirements; as well as socio-economic, cultural heritage, and natural environment factors.

Rehabilitation of Glasgow Road is being completed as a **Schedule “A+”** project in accordance with the *Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (October 2000, amended in 2007, 2011 & 2015)*.

Preferred Alternative Solution

Through consultation with Agencies, Members of the Public, and Indigenous Communities, the preferred solution for the rehabilitation Glasgow Road is to maintain current rural roadway cross-section with addition of Active Transportation Facility (MUP) on one side. Rehabilitation of the Glasgow Road segment including pavement structure, shoulders, improved ditching and widening to accommodate a multi-use path on one side of the roadway, as well as providing a link to a new facility on one side of Deer Valley Drive.
