

**NOTICE TO BANKS**

*Municipal Elections Act, 1996, s.88.22(1)*

May 1, 2026

To: Financial Institution

Re: Municipal Elections Campaign Account

A candidate, running in the Town of Caledon 2026 Municipal and School Board Elections, is required under the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996* to open an account in the name of their campaign (for example: "Campaign for Jane Doe" or "Jane Doe's Campaign") prior to incurring any expenses or accepting contributions of money.

The Act does not contain any prohibition against a municipal candidate being a signing officer on the campaign account, nor does it require the candidate to have a chief financial officer, as is the case with provincial and federal candidates.
