

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF CALEDON

BY-LAW NO. 2025-048

A By-law to provide for a home voting service during the advance voting period for the 2026 Town of Caledon Municipal and School Board Election

WHEREAS Section 42(1) of the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996, S.O. 1996, c. 32, Sched., as amended*, provides that the council of a local municipality may pass a By-law authorizing electors to use an alternative voting method that does not require electors to attend at a voting place in order to vote;

AND WHEREAS Section 43 of the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996, as amended*, provides that the clerk is responsible for establishing the dates, the times, the number, and the location of voting places for the advance vote as each local municipality shall hold an advance vote on one or more dates provided the dates are not more than 30 days before voting day;

AND WHEREAS Section 44 of the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996, as amended*, permits an eligible elector in a local municipality to appoint another eligible elector as their voting proxy;

AND WHEREAS Council deems it desirable that a limited home voting service be provided as an alternative voting method for electors who cannot leave their homes due to illness, injury or disability;


NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the Town of Caledon ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:


1. A limited home voting service may be offered to the satisfaction of the Municipal Clerk to electors who cannot leave their homes because of illness, injury or disability may be used by such electors as an alternative voting method during the advance voting period for the 2026 Municipal and School Board Election, in accordance with such procedures, forms, capacity limitations and at such dates and times as may be established by the Municipal Clerk in conformance with the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996, as amended*.
2. Section 43 of the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996, as amended*, with respect to advanced voting shall apply to the alternative voting method contemplated in section 1 of this by-law.
3. Section 44 of the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996, as amended*, with respect to proxy voting shall not apply to the alternative voting method contemplated in section 1 of this by-law.

Enactment

This By-law shall come into full force and effect on the day of its passing.
