

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF CALEDON

BY-LAW NO. 2026-017

A By-law to provide for the annual remuneration of Council members, the authorization of expenses to be paid and to repeal By-law 2023-014 and its amending By-law 2025-053

WHEREAS the *Municipal Act, 2001* section 283(2) provides a municipality may only pay the expenses of the members of its council or of a local board of the municipality and of the officers and employees of the municipality or local board if the expenses are of those persons in their capacity as members, officers or employees and if, the expenses are actually incurred; or the expenses are, in lieu of the expenses actually incurred, a reasonable estimate, in the opinion of the council or local board, of the actual expenses that would be incurred;

AND WHEREAS the *Municipal Act, 2001* section 284(2) provides that a municipality shall identify the by-law under which the remuneration or expenses were authorized to be paid;


AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the Town of Caledon deems it necessary to repeal and replace By-law 2023-014 to reflect recent changes to the annual remuneration for members of Council;


NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the Town of Caledon ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Mayor shall receive an annual remuneration of \$127,742 for the calendar year, annually adjusted to increase by 3.62% per year over the course of the 2026-2030 Term of Council, and any cost of living adjustments as approved by Council.
2. Councillors shall receive an annual remuneration of \$54,437 for the calendar year, annually adjusted to increase by 3.75% per year over the course of the 2026-2030 Term of Council, and any cost of living adjustments as approved by Council.
3. Such remuneration shall be paid following the same schedule as the payment of wages and salaries for staff, and in the event of the death of a member of Council or upon their ceasing to be a member for any reason before the expiration of their term of office, the amount payable to them or their personal representative(s) shall be in proportion to the period of their service during such term.
4. The annual remuneration paid to members of Council does not include their remuneration as a member of Peel Regional Council or any agency, board, commission, corporation, society or other similar organization to which the member is appointed by Council. This remuneration shall be separate and above the annual remuneration paid to members of Council.
5. Members of Council shall be entitled to receive the following benefits upon the same terms that are made available to staff of the Town:
  - (1) Extended Health and Dental Insurance,
  - (2) Group Life Insurance,
  - (3) Accidental Death and Dismemberment Insurance, and
  - (4) Participation in the Ontario Municipal Employees Retirement System (OMERS).
6. Council expenses are authorized to be paid as prescribed in an established Council Expense Policy as approved by Council resolution.
7. By-law 2023-014 and its amending By-law 2025-053 thereto are hereby repealed.

This By-law shall come into full force and effect on November 15, 2026.
