Decision Not to Veto By-laws

To give written notice for the approval of by-laws.

Under the Authority: Part VI.1 (Special Powers and Duties of Head of Council) of the *Municipal Act, 2001* in accordance with subsection 284.11(4) (By-law commencement) of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, a by-law that is subject to this section shall be deemed not to have been passed by council if notice has not been given under section 284.11(3) to veto the by-law, or until the day written approval of the by-law is given by the head of council to the municipality:

I, Annette Groves, Mayor of the Town of Caledon, give approval to the following by-laws passed at the Town Council meeting on March, 6, 2024:

1. All By-laws enacted under the motion to approve the By-laws (Agenda Item 8.1 to 8.2); and
