Inclusivity and Consistency

Consistency

Update / modernize and to provide for greater consistency with the City of Brampton (2016 as Amendment) & the City of Mississauga (2015 as Amendment)

Cultural Inclusivity

Permit additional observances of Diwali, Chinese New Year and New Year's Eve

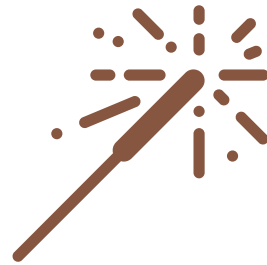
Community Inclusivity

Permit community groups to set-off aerial fireworks with a Permit (obtained by a Fireworks Supervisor)

Fire Safety Enhancements



Restrict types of consumer fireworks sold and discharged within the Town



Permit only non-aerial consumer fireworks for the use by the public on approved observances



Establish minimum safe distances from schools, vulnerable occupancies, industrial facilities and fuel dispensing stations

Fire Safety Enhancements



Set safe handling, discharge, extinguishing and disposal provision for consumer fireworks.



Regulate times (dusk to 11:00 pm) for the discharging of all fireworks



Display fireworks may only be discharged at Public Events (no private events) by a Fireworks Supervisor

Enforcement



Provide for Part 1 notices (tickets) that can be issued for all regulations contained within the By-law



Include set fines for Part 1 notices consistent with other municipalities
