MAIN STREET SOUTH / QUEEN STREET EAST

Alton Village Streetscaping / Bridge and Culvert Replacement over Shaw's Creek

Dear Business Owner:

The Region of Peel is developing plans for the proposed improvements to Main Street South / Queen Street East (Regional Road 136). The proposed work is scheduled for 2018.

The Region is dedicated to keeping its infrastructure in good repair. The proposed improvements will improve safety, provide connectivity to features and attractions, and encourage walking and cycling within the village.

Open Houses

The Region of Peel is committed to keeping all businesses and residents informed of the upcoming construction. Your opinion matters and we are holding two Public Information Centres, where we will provide additional information and answer your questions:

- The first is on Wednesday, October 18, 2017, from 6:30 to 8:30 p.m., at the Alton Public School
- The second is to be determined, in January, when we will also provide detour maps

Two-phase Project

<u>Phase 1 – scheduled for March 2018</u>: improvements to Queen Street East include reconstructing the road, replacing the bridge and culvert over Shaw's Creek, improving drainage, and providing on-street parking, boulevard improvements, streetscaping enhancements (such as rest areas and benches) and landscaping.

Phase 1 will require full road closure of Queen Street East, between the railway tracks and Alton Grange Trail access. We will provide detour signs and maps.

<u>Phase 2 – scheduled for May 2018</u>: improvements to Main Street South/Queen Street East include resurfacing the road, reconfiguring the intersection, improving drainage, and providing on-street parking, new retaining walls, boulevard improvements, decorative streetlighting and streetscaping enhancements.

Phase 2 will require temporary day-time lane closure from Beechgrove Side Road to the railway tracks and could result in some delays.
