Wireless Emergency Alerts Are Here: Starting April 6, 2018, in addition to TV and radio, Alert Ready will be sending life-threatening emergency alerts to cell phones. The geo-targeted alerts will warn Canadians about dangers and imminent threats to life and property so they can take appropriate action.

A Province-wide test will take place on Monday, May 7, 2018, 1:55 pm EST and again on September 19th.
