About the Walk of Fame

The Caledon Walk of Fame was launched in 1999 to honour past and present Caledon residents.

It honours distinguished Caledon residents past and present such as filmmakers Cory Trépanier and Norman Jewison, authors Farley Mowat and Robertson Davies, hockey builder Conn Smythe, broadcaster Taylor 'Hap' Parnaby.

The Walk of Fame is located at the Great Trail Pavilion Park on the west side of Airport Road in Caledon East. A stone is placed in honour of each recipient during a formal Walk of Fame ceremony, held annually when there is a qualifying nominee.
