Music in the Park: Call for musicians

April 2023

Objective: The Town of Caledon is inviting musicians and bands to apply to perform in our new Music in the Park series. Music in the Park is free to attend and encourages residents and families to enjoy local entertainment in the summer weather. This is a community project initiative by the Town's Economic Development department.

Eligibility: Preference will be given to Caledon musicians and bands, although we welcome applicants from the greater Region of Peel area.

Deadline: Please complete the form linked below by April 30, 2023.

Performer Fee: Performers or bands will be compensated \$300 for a two-hour performance.

Dates and Times:

Music in the Park will take place weekly on Thursday evenings, from July to August 2023, at Dennison Park in Southfields village. Performances are scheduled from 6:30 - 8:30 p.m. The Town will try to accommodate preferences but in case of conflict dates will be allocated on a first-come, first-served basis. The last two dates will be held as rain dates in case of inclement weather.

Musician/Band Conditions and Responsibilities:

- Provide their own equipment
- Ensure setup is complete prior to 6:30 p.m.
- Provides family-friendly, acoustic, live music from 6:30 p.m. – 8:30 p.m.
- Agrees to perform, regardless of the weather, unless the event is cancelled by the Town of Caledon
- Thoroughly complete all aspects of the application form linked below
- Provide all necessary information for payment
- Provide proof of insurance coverage (\$2 million in commercial general liability with the Town added as an additional insurer)
