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EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Soil Engineers Ltd. (SEL) was retained by Bolton Summit Developments Inc. to carry out a Phase One Environmental Site Assessment (Phase One ESA) at a property located at 13290 Nunnville Road, in the Town of Caledon (Bolton) (hereinafter referred to as the 'subject site').

The purpose of the study was to identify any potential environmental concerns associated with the subject site. The findings from our research of documents pertaining to the subject site, interviews with persons knowledgeable of the subject site, and an environmental site reconnaissance, together with our assessment, are presented in this report.

The records review, interview and site inspection indicates that the subject site has been used as a residential property since 1966. The neighbouring properties consist of residential properties to the all directions. The subject site is located adjacent to a roadway (Nunnville Road to the east of the subject site).

SEL Phase One ESA has revealed that there is low potential for environmental concerns attendant to the subject site. Therefore, no further environmental investigation is recommended as SEL find that the subject site is suitable for the proposed development.



INTRODUCTION

Soil Engineers Ltd. (SEL) has carried out a Phase One Environmental Site Assessment (Phase One ESA), as defined by Ontario Regulation (O. Reg.) 153/04, as amended by O. Regs. 366/05, 66/08, 511/09, 245/10, 179/11, 269/11 and 333/13, hereinafter referred to as O. Reg. 153/04 made under Environmental Protection Act (EPA) for a property located at 13290 Nunnville Road, in the Town of Caledon (hereinafter referred to as the 'subject site').

2.1 **Phase One Property Information**

The subject site, as shown on the Site Location Plan, Drawing No. 1, is located on the west side of Nunnville Road and approximately 120 metres (m) south of Old King Road. The Municipal address of the subject site is 13290 Nunnville Road, in the Town of Caledon (Bolton). The subject site is comprised of one (1) residential Property Identification Number (PIN), 14355-1313 (LT) as shown on the Property Index Map, Drawing No. 2.

The property information obtained from the Parcel Register, land transfer documents, MPAC report and the UTM coordinates obtained from Google Earth are given in the table below:

The subject site is irregular in shape, with an approximate area of 0.85 hectares (ha) (2.11 acres (ac)).



Municipal Property Assessment Corporation (MPAC)

A MPAC Residential Primary Structure Report was retrieved for the property on the subject site. A copy of the report is included in Appendix 'A'. The Municipal Roll Number is 2124010002077000000. The Property Code and Description was documented as "301 – Single-family detached (not on water)." The on-site structure at 13290 Nunnville was built in 1966, and the property is serviced with municipal hydro with unspecified service for water and sanitary. In addition, the on-site building was equipped with forced air heating and air conditioning.

SCOPE OF INVESTIGATION

The general objectives of a Phase One ESA, as defined by Part VII and Schedule D of O. Reg. 153/04 of the EPA, are the following:

- To develop a preliminary determination of the likelihood that one or more contaminants have affected any land or water on, in or under the subject site.
- To determine the need for a Phase Two Environmental Site Assessment (Phase Two ESA).
- To provide a basis for carrying out any required Phase Two ESA.
- To provide adequate preliminary information about the environmental conditions
 in the land or water on, in or under the subject site, in order to conduct a risk
 assessment following the completion of a Phase Two ESA, if required.

A Phase One ESA generally consists of the following components:

- Records review.
- Interview(s).
- Site reconnaissance.
- An evaluation of the information gathered from the records review, interviews and site reconnaissance.
- Completion of a Phase One ESA report.
- The submission of the Phase One ESA report to the commissioner of the report.

This Phase One ESA was commissioned in support of proposed residential development. It is anticipated that the new development will be provided with municipal services meeting urban standards.



RECORDS REVIEW

4.1 General

(i) Phase One Study Area

Except where noted, the Phase One Study Area generally consists of the subject site plus all properties that are located, wholly or partially, within 250 m beyond the perimeter boundaries of the subject site.

(ii) First Developed Use

The first developed use of the subject site is defined by O. Reg. 153/04 as the earlier of either the first use in or after 1875 that resulted in the development of a building or a structure on the subject site, or the first potentially contaminating use or activity on the subject site.

A Historical Map dated 1877 was located from McGill University on February 3, 2022. A copy of the map is presented on Drawing No. 3, showing that the subject site was located in rural area of Nunnville at that time. The subject site was most likely used for agricultural purposes. A roadway was located adjacent to the subject site.

(iii) Fire Insurance Plans

A search for Fire Insurance Plans (FIPs) for the subject site and properties within the Phase One Study Area was conducted at the Toronto Reference Library on February 3, 2022. No fire insurance plan is available for the subject site or for the Phase One Study Area.



(iv) Chain of Title

A land title search was conducted for the subject site on February 2, 2022.

The information from the Parcel Register and Land Title research are listed in Appendix 'B'. The earliest records show that the subject site was part of Lot 7 in the 8th Concession, Albion within the Town of Caledon. The subject site was part of the land patented by the Crown to Joseph Mackwell in 1825.

Throughout the researched years, the land was subdivided, with the ownership of the subject site changing several times between private individuals and companies. The most recent transaction for the subject site is listed in the table below:

(v) Environmental Reports

SEL is not aware of any previous environmental reports prepared for the subject site.



4.2 **Environmental Source Information**

(i) Ministry of the Environment, Conservation and Parks (MECP)

Waste Disposal Sites

Active and closed landfill sites located in excess of 1 kilometre (km) from the subject site are considered to have no significant potential for environmental impact at the subject site. On January 30, 2022, SEL reviewed the MECP "Waste Disposal Site Inventory", dated June 1991. There is one record of inactive waste disposal site within 673 m west of the subject site and it was closed in 1960.

<u>Industrial Sites Producing or Using Coal Tar and Related Tars in Ontario</u>

On January 30, 2022, SEL reviewed the MECP "Inventory of Industrial Sites Producing or Using Coal Tar and Related Tars in Ontario", dated November 1988, and the "Inventory of Coal Gasification Plant Waste Sites in Ontario", dated April 1987.

There is no record of any coal gasification plant, coal tar distillation plant, creosote plant, etc., at or within the vicinity of the subject site. All facilities of this nature are located in excess of 1 km from the subject site and are considered to have no significant potential for environmental impact at the subject site.

Polychlorinated biphenyl (PCB) Waste Storage Sites

The MECP "Ontario Inventory of PCB Storage Sites", dated October 1991 and April 1995 respectively, were reviewed on January 30, 2022. The subject site is not listed as a PCB waste storage site, and no PCB waste storage site is located within the Phase One Study Area.



MECP Waste Generator

On January 30, 2022, the MECP Waste Generator Registration database files, dated 2000, 2008, 2015, 2018 and 2020, were reviewed. The subject site is not listed as a waste generator under Regulation 347, as amended of the EPA and no properties within the Phase One Study Area are listed as waste generators in this database.

Records of Site Condition (RSC)

On January 30, 2022, the MECP Brownfields Environmental Site Registry database was reviewed to determine whether any RSC had been filed for the subject site or any of the surrounding properties within the Phase One Study Area. One RSC was filed for a property within the Phase One Study Area. Additional information is present as follow:

MECP Freedom of Information

A request for documented environmental concerns and citations pertaining to the subject site was forwarded to the MECP Freedom of Information Office on February 3, 2022. No response has been received at the time of writing this report. In the event that their response suggests cause for concern, it will be forwarded together with an assessment of its significance. A copy of the MECP Freedom of Information request form is included in Appendix 'C'.



(ii) Environment Canada

National Pollutant Release Inventory (NPRI)

On January 30, 2022, the Environment Canada NPRI database files were reviewed. The subject site is not registered in the NPRI database and no properties within the Phase One Study Area are registered in the NPRI database.

National PCB Inventory

On January 30, 2022, the Environment Canada PCB Inventory database files, dated 1994, were reviewed. The subject site is not registered in the National PCB Inventory database. In addition, no properties within the Phase One Study Area were listed in the database.

(iii) Other Sources

Municipal Freedom of Information

A request for documented environmental concerns and citations pertaining to the subject site was forwarded to the Town of Caledon on February 1, 2022. No response has been received at the time of writing this report. In the event that their response suggests cause for concern, it will be forwarded together with an assessment of its significance. The request form is presented in Appendix 'C'.

Technical Standards & Safety Authority (TSSA)

The use of underground storage tanks (USTs) containing petroleum products is regulated in Ontario by the Ministry of Consumer and Commercial Relations (MCCR) under various legislative instruments, including the Gasoline Handling Act and Energy Act. Above-ground and underground storage tanks that contain petroleum products are required by law to be registered with the MCCR, and the TSSA is responsible for keeping records of these tanks. Customer Services of the



TSSA was contacted on January 28, 2022, regarding possible registration, size and age of USTs and above-ground storage tanks (ASTs) at the subject site and selected surrounding properties. On January 28, 2022, they informed us that they had no records for the listed properties. It should be noted that TSSA records are only reliable from 1987 to the present. A copy of TSSA response is presented in Appendix "D".

Environmental Risk Assessment Service (ERIS) Ltd.

ERIS Ltd. provides reports that compile information from both government and private databases of interest to the environmental field. The ERIS database report was conducted (Report No. 20190607069), dated June 12, 2019 for a adjacent property with the records for the subject site, can be found in Appendix 'E'. The database and number of notable records found pertaining to the subject site and Phase One Study Area are listed in the table below:

Certificates of Approval (CA)

The database contains discharge approval for air and noise, industrial sewage, and municipal and private sewage, waste management systems and renewable energy approval. CA databases indicate no record for the subject site; however, there are two (2) CA approvals (municipal water and municipal sewage) for two (2) properties within the Phase One Study Area. Refer to Appendix E for details.

These environmental databases are not considered to pose environmental concerns to the subject site.



TSSA Historic Incidents (HINC)

The TSSA maintains a database of all fuel related incidents in Ontario, i.e., pipe line breaches, gas leaks, etc.

According to the ERIS report, there are two (2) records of TSSA historic incidents at the properties located within the Phase One Study Area. Details are listed in the table below:

Airbourne releases are not considered to be environmental concerns with respect to the subject site. Refer to Appendix E for details.

Pesticide Register (PES)

The Ontario MECP obtains information regarding vendors and operators of registered pesticides. According to the ERIS report, one (1) record pertaining to pesticide vendor is listed within the Phase One Study Area. Towne Hardware is located at 187 Old King Road (approximately 183 m north of the subject site). Refer to Appendix E for details.

Ontario Spills (SPL)

Information such as the location (approximate), type and quantity of contaminant, date of spill, environmental impact, cause, nature of impact, etc. are recorded in the database from 1988 to 2011. One (1) spill incident is listed in the database. Details are listed in the table below:

4.3 Physical Setting Sources

(i) Aerial Photographs

Aerial photographs dated 1954, 1969, 1976, 1985, 1995, 2001, 2009 and 2022, showing the subject site and surrounding area, were found at Town of Caledon Air History Caledon Maps, University of Toronto, SEL Library, Trent University, National Air Photo Library and Google Earth on February 3, 2022. Copies of the aerial photographs are presented in Appendix 'F'. A review of the aerial photographs is summarized in the table below:

A roadway is observed to the east of subject site since 1954.

(ii) Topography, Hydrology, Geology

Maps of the area were located at Ontario Ministry of Natural Resources and Forestry on January 24, 2022. A 2003 Ontario Base Map (OBM) and a Topographic Map in 2022 were available for our review, showing the land



features at those dates. Copies of the maps are presented on Drawing Nos. 4 and 5, respectively, showing that one (1) structure building is located at the subject site as per OBM. A chronological review of the maps indicates land features of the subject site are consistent with those shown on the aerial photographs. Based on the topography of the area, precipitation runoff on the subject site is expected to flow in a northerly direction.

Geological maps of the area were located at the Ontario Geological Survey and the Bedrock Geology of Ontario Database on January 24, 2022. A surface geology map is presented on Drawing No. 6, showing that the subject site is underlain by Halton Till with Material documented as predominantly silt to silty clay matrix, high in matrix carbonate content and clast poor. A bedrock geology map is presented on Drawing No. 7 showing that the subject site is underlain by Georgian Bay Formation, Blue Mountain formation, Billings Formation, Collingwood Member and Eastview Member with rock description was documented as shale, limestone, dolostone and siltstone.

The subject site is located in the larger hydrogeological region known as Southern Ontario Lowlands. A watershed map of the area was obtained from Land Information Ontario (LIO) on January 24, 2022. A copy of the map is presented on Drawing No. 8. The map indicates that the subject site is situated within the Humber River-Don River Watershed.

According to the Ontario Geological Survey Bedrock Drift Thickness Database, accessed on January 24, 2022, the bedrock at the subject site is overlain by 88 m of drift.

(iii) Fill Material and Topsoil

The records review did not indicate that any fill material was brought onto the subject site.



(iv) Water Bodies and Areas of Natural Significance

Ontario Ministry of Natural Resources and Forestry (OMNRF)

SEL reviewed the OMNRF and Natural Heritage Information Centre (NHIC) database on January 24, 2022 for listings of the various classes of natural areas located in the vicinity of the subject site. According to the database, a watercourse (Humber River) is located approximately 157 m to the north of the subject site. Wooded areas are located at the western and eastern portions of the subject site. In addition, wooded areas are located to the west, north and east beyond the roadway of the subject site. A copy of the Natural Features and Protection Area Plan is presented on Drawing No. 9.

Planning Authorities/Wellhead Protection Areas

The Source Water Protection Map was reviewed on January 24, 2022. Based on our review, the subject site is not located in a Well-head Protection Area.

(v) Well Records

The MECP's help desk at Water Well Ontario was contacted on January 24, 2022 regarding the subject site and the surrounding area. No well was located at the subject site; however, fourteen (14) additional well records are located within the Phase One Study Area. Some of the wells were documented for domestic use. A copy of the MECP Well Records is included in Appendix 'G'.

4.4 Occupancy Search

An occupancy search for the subject site and properties within the Phase One Study Area was conducted on February 3, 2022, using the 1962-1963, 1964, 1966, 1969–1970, 1972–1973, 1975, 1979, 1982, 1985, 1989, 1992, 1995, 1998 and 2001 City Directories at the Toronto Reference Library.



A review of the occupancy records shows that no records were found for the subject site with two (2) records were located in the Phase One Study Area. There are no concerns with these records. A copy of the Occupancy Records is located in Appendix 'H'.

4.5 Records Review Summary

A summary of the relevant information disclosed by our records review as of February 3, 2022, is given below:

- The subject site has been the residential property since 1966. (Sources: MPAC Report, Maps, Aerial Photographs)
- One (1) spill incident was reported for a property located within the Phase One Study Area. (Source: ERIS Report)
- One (1) pesticide vendor record was located within the Phase One Study Area.
 (Source: ERIS Report)
- One (1) closed waste disposal site was located approximately 673 m to the west of the subject site. (Sources: Record Review)
- A watercourse (Humber River) is located approximately 157 m north of subject site. (Source: Maps, Aerial Photographs, and OMNRF)
- The subject site is adjacent to a roadway. (Nunnville Road to the east of the subject site). (Source: Maps, Aerial Photographs)



5.0 INTERVIEW

5.1 Owner Interview

Mr. Peter Canali and Ms. Marilena Canali, the current owner of the subject site, was interviewed on January 26, 2022. They indicated that water well and septic systems are located at the subject site. In addition, they informed SEL that no spills, leaks, fuel odours or stained surfaces, chemical use, or any above ground or under ground storage tanks at the subject site. There were no previous environmental site assessments completed for the subject site. A copy of the interview documents is included in Appendix 'I'.

5.2 Summary of Interview

The interview has disclosed the following items of environmental concern with regards to the subject site:

- The subject site is a residential property.
- Domestic water well and septic system are located at the subject site.



SITE RECONNAISSANCE

6.1 General

A visual inspection of the subject site and the Phase One Study Area from the publicly accessible areas was conducted by our representatives, Ms. Ankita Patel, M.Sc. (Chem), on January 26, 2022, to determine the general environmental conditions of the subject site. The conditions and timing of the site visit are presented in the table below:

Site photographs taken during the inspection are presented in Appendix 'J'.

At the time of the inspection, the subject site at 13290 Nunnville Road, is comprised of a residential building with one (1) attached garage and one (1) detached garage. There are wood fences along the eastern and southern site boundaries, no fencing along western and northern boundaries. A roadway (Nunnville Road) is located adjacent east of the subject site. The neighbouring properties are residential properties in all directions.

The subject site is relatively flat. There residential structure at the subject site is heated with natural gas. There is a septic tank system located at the northwest of the subject site. A water well is located at the north of the residential house. At the first time of inspection on January 26, the subject site was snow covered; however, there was no snow on the ground and the ground area was found to be covered by grass as this was revealed during the site inspection on April 22. There was no evidence to suggest that materials of environmental concern are disposed of at the subject site.



6.2 Specific Observations at Phase One Property

(i) Building Inspection

At the time of the site inspection, one (1) residential with attached garage and a detached garage were present at the subject site. The residential building was built in 1966. The house is bungalow style including finished basement, with concrete foundation, brick siding, and asphalt roof shingles. The ground floor contained a dining area, kitchen area, bedrooms, laundry and bathrooms. The basement contained recreational rooms, utility room, and bathroom as well as water treatment and filtration system. The house is serviced with hydro, water well, septic system and it is heated with natural gas. There is no visible staining on the concrete in the basement areas. A car was observed inside the attached garage with the garage floor is concrete.

The detached garage was found to have wooden structure with concrete flooring and asphalt roofing.

(ii) Hazardous Materials

Asbestos-Containing Materials (ACMs)

ACMs were widely used in building construction until the mid- to late 1970s, primarily for the good insulation and fire retardant properties of asbestos. The health risks associated with asbestos occur when asbestos fibres are released from various materials into the ambient air.

Based on the age of the buildings, it is possible that ACMs were used during the building construction.



PCBs

PCBs commonly exist in electrical equipment such as transformers, capacitors, and in the ballasts of fluorescent and high-intensity discharge (HID) light fixtures. The use of PCBs in newly manufactured electrical equipment was discontinued in 1979.

Based on the age of the buildings, it is possible that PCBs were present in the electrical equipment on the subject site.

Urea-Formaldehyde Foam Insulation (UFFI)

UFFI was commonly used in the in the pasr for insulation in buildings and was discontinued in 1980.

Based on the age of the buildings, it is possible that UFFI were used in the building construction.

Ozone-Depleting Substances (ODSs)

ODSs are found in the form of chlorofluorocarbons (CFCs) used in airconditioning units and refrigeration systems.

Based on our inspection, sources of ODSs are likely limited to minor quantities present in the refrigeration/freezer units and air conditioners and do not pose an environmental risk if the units are properly serviced and maintained. The refrigeration/freezer units and air conditioning unit appeared to be in good condition, and no leakage was noticed.



Lead

Lead was commonly used in old plumbing pipes and solder, in the manufacturing of paint as a drying agent and for pigmentation. The use of lead has been reduced, and was phased out of use, in plumbing solder during the 1980s and from pipes during the 1990s. The use of lead in the manufacturing of new paint was phased out during the 1970s for interior house paint and during the late 1990s for exterior paint.

Based on the age of the buildings, it is possible that lead-based materials may be present on the painted surfaces of the buildings. Although the pipes are made of copper, it is possible that lead-based solder may have been used. No deteriorating painted surfaces were observed.

Mercury

Mercury is generally a component of thermometers, thermostats and fluorescent lighting tubes. Our visual inspection of the subject site indicated that these items were in use. Provided that these items are left intact, they remain safe in their present form.

Silica

Silica is a natural material found in rocks and masonry units. Our inspection indicated that these materials were used in the construction of the building. As long as these materials remain in their solid form and do not show signs of deterioration (or dusting), they remain safe.

(iii) Underground Storage Tanks (USTs)

There is no vent or filler pipe visible to indicate the presence of UST on the subject site during the site reconnaissance.



(iv) Above-Ground Storage Tanks (ASTs)

At the time of site inspection, no AST was observed on the subject site during the site reconnaissance.

(v) Substance Containers

Our representative checked for the presence of substance containers such as oil drums, used oil containers, gasoline jerry cans, paint cans, etc. At the time of inspection, no substance containers are observed at the subject site.

(vi) Waste Management and Maintenance Practices

Solid waste, in the form of general mixed reuse and recyclables is collected and contained in the appropriate disposal bins which are collected by the Town in the regular basis.

(vii) Air Quality and Noise

During our inspection, there was no offensive odour or detectable source of air emissions that may impact the ambient air quality at the subject site. No unexpected noise level greater than the ambient is noted at the subject site. In this case, ambient noise includes the noise of traffic along roadway (Nunnville Road adjacent to the east of the subject site).

(viii) Water Wells

At the time of the inspection on January 26, a water well was located at the north of the residential house at the subject. During the site visit on April 22, four (4) newly installed hydrogelogical monitoring wells were found to be located to the north, south and east of residential building at the subject site.



(ix) Phase One Study Area Inspection

Based on our visual inspection of the publicly accessible areas, the neighbouring properties consist of residential properties in all directions. Subject site is located adjacent to a roadway (Nunnville Road to the east of the subject site).

(x) Enhanced Property Investigation

There is no industrial processing, dry cleaning service, or chemical manufacturing or handling carried out at the subject site at the time of this Phase One ESA. No record of such activities in the past was recovered for the subject site during our search. Therefore, no enhanced property investigation was conducted.

6.3 Summary of Site Reconnaissance

Our site reconnaissance, conducted on Jan 26, 2022, has revealed the following items which warrant further discussion:

- The subject site is a residential property.
- Hazardous materials may be present at the subject site.
- Water well and septic tank systems are located to the north and northwest of the subject site. Four (4) newly installed hydrogeological monitoring wells were located to the east, north and south of the residential building at the subject site.
- The subject site was covered by grasses.
- The subject site is adjacent to a roadway. (Nunnville Road)



REVIEW AND EVALUATION OF INFORMATION

7.1 Current and Past Uses

The records review indicates that the subject site has been a residential property since 1966.

A description of the major uses of the subject site and the year in which they appear to have commenced is presented in the Table of Current and Past Use, Appendix 'K'.

7.2 <u>Discussion of Environmental Items</u>

Based on our review of records, interviews and site reconnaissance, as of February 3, 2022 the following information pertaining to the environmental condition of the subject site has been disclosed by the Phase One ESA:

- The subject has been a residential property since 1966. (Sources: MPAC report, Aerial Photographs, Site Reconnaissance and Interview)
- One (1) spill incident is reported within the Phase One Study Area. (Source: ERIS Report)
- One (1) pesticide vendor record was documented within the Phase One Study Area. (Source: ERIS Report)
- One (1) closed waste disposal site was located approximately 673 m to the west of the subject site. (Sources: Environmental Source Information Waste Disposal)
- Domestic Water well and septic tank/system are located at the subject site.
 (Sources: Records Review, Interview and Site Reconnaissance)
- The subject site is adjacent to a roadway (Nunnville Road to the east of the subject site). (Sources: Records Review and Site Inspection)



(i) Potentially Contaminating Activity

A Potentially Contaminating Activity (PCA) is defined by O. Reg. 153/04 as a use or an activity that is occurring or has occurred in a Phase One Study Area, as per Table 2 of Schedule "D".

We have evaluated the risks associated with specific items in the above list to determine the potential for that activity to impact the environmental condition of the subject site.

Pesticides Vendor

Based on the ERIS report, one (1) property in the Phase One Study Area listed as pesticide vendor, Towne Hardware. The pesticide vender is located approximately 183 m north of the subject site. It is likely that the property carries only small amounts of pesticides for sale, and that the pesticides are stored at the property. They are not considered as a PCA.

Spills

Based on the ERIS report, one (1) spill incident is reported for a property located within the Phase One Study Area. The spill occurred 120 m west of the subject site. It is located significantly far from the subject site and down gradient to the subject site; therefore, it is considered to posses a low potential to influence the environmental condition at the subject site. This item is not listed in the Table 2 of Schedule 'D' of O. Reg 153/04. #Other. Spill

Waste Disposal

Based on the Environmental Source Information (records review), one (1) closed waste disposal site was located approximately 673 m to the west of the subject site. Since, it is located significantly far from the subject site and down gradient to the subject site, therefore it is considered to posses a low potential to influence the



environmental condition at the subject site. This item is not listed in the Table 2 of Schedule 'D' of O. Reg 153/04.

(ii) Other Environmental Items

Designated/Hazardous Substances

Hazardous materials may be present in the on-site building. As the building is not part of the development plan, the designated substances will normally be dealt with by the builders or contractors prior to demolition of the structures, if any, through applicable regulations under the Occupational Health and the Safety Act.

Adjacent Roadways

The subject site is adjacent to a roadway (Nunnville Road to the east of the subject site). This is of concern due to the de-icing chemicals used during the winter season which may result in higher than usual levels for the Sodium Adsorption Ratio and Electrical Conductivity of the soil. If the soil remains in situ, it is considered to meet the standards through clause 48(3) of O. Reg. 153/04. However, should the material be displaced, it will no longer qualify for this exemption and must be managed accordingly.

Water Bodies and Areas of Natural Significance

There are no areas of natural and scientific interest located on the subject site.

Wells and Septic Systems

Based on the records review, interviews and site inspection, there is domestic well and septic system on the subject site.



7.3 Areas of Potential Environmental Concern

Based on our review of the activities identified at the subject site and Phase One Study Area, no Area of Potential Environmental Concern (APEC) was identified at the subject site.

7.4 Phase One Conceptual Site Plan

A Study Conceptual Site Plan illustrating the findings and results of the assessment is presented on Drawing No. 10.



CONCLUSIONS

Soil Engineers Ltd. was retained by Bolton Summit Developments Inc. to carry out a Phase One Environmental Site Assessment (Phase One ESA) for a property located at 13290 Nunnville Road, Caledon, Ontario (the 'subject site'). The subject site has been for residential use since 1966. The neighbouring properties consist of residential properties in all directions. The subject site is located adjacent to a roadway (Nunnville Road to the east of the subject site).

8.1 Study Assessment Recommendation

SEL Study Past Use Environmental Site Assessment (ESA) has revealed that there is low potential for environmental concerns attendant to the subject site. Therefore, no further environmental investigation is recommended as SEL find the subject site is suitable for the proposed development.

8.2 **RSC Requirements**

Based on the type of development proposed for the subject site, a record of site condition (RSC) is not required to be filed in accordance with Ontario Regulation (O. Reg.) 153/04, as amended.

Please note that if there is an intent to file a RSC, in accordance with O. Reg. 153/04, any environmental reports including a Phase One ESA must be dated within 18 months of the date of filing.

8.3 Environmental Site Assessment (ESA), Body of Water, Area of Natural and Scientific Interest (ANSI)

Based on the records review and site reconnaissance, no area of natural and scientific interest (ANSI), sensitive area is located within the subject site or within 30 m from the



subject site boundaries. However, a watercourse is located approximately 157 m north of the subject site.

8.4 Legal Requirements

If an RSC has been submitted and filed, the property owner must retain a copy of this report for at least seven (7) years in accordance with O. Reg. 153/04, Section 18.

The objectives and requirements as set out in the O. Reg. 153/04, as amended, for a Phase One ESA were applied in carrying out the environmental site assessment and in the preparation of this report.








General view of water main in basement
