Site Review: June 23rd, 2009

Comments:

A final site review was completed in the morning of June 23rd, 2009 to review the completed work of restoring the Alton Mill.


At the time of the review:

1. The structural work for the building renovation identified on the certified drawings and additional work identified during the course of construction was complete, including the lower level flood-proofing measures (windows, elevated concrete at entry, courtyard repairs etc.).
2. The structural work for the new entry bridge, including the bridge abutments was complete.

During the course of construction of the above project, personnel from our firm carried out periodic site reviews of the structural work in accordance with the requirements of Div. C Part 1 the Ontario Building Code.

On the basis of these reviews, review of the structural shop drawings, and the basis of reports submitted to our firm by independent testing and inspection firms, it is our opinion that the structural work is in general conformity with the Ontario Building Code, and the drawings and specifications prepared by Tacoma Engineers Inc.
