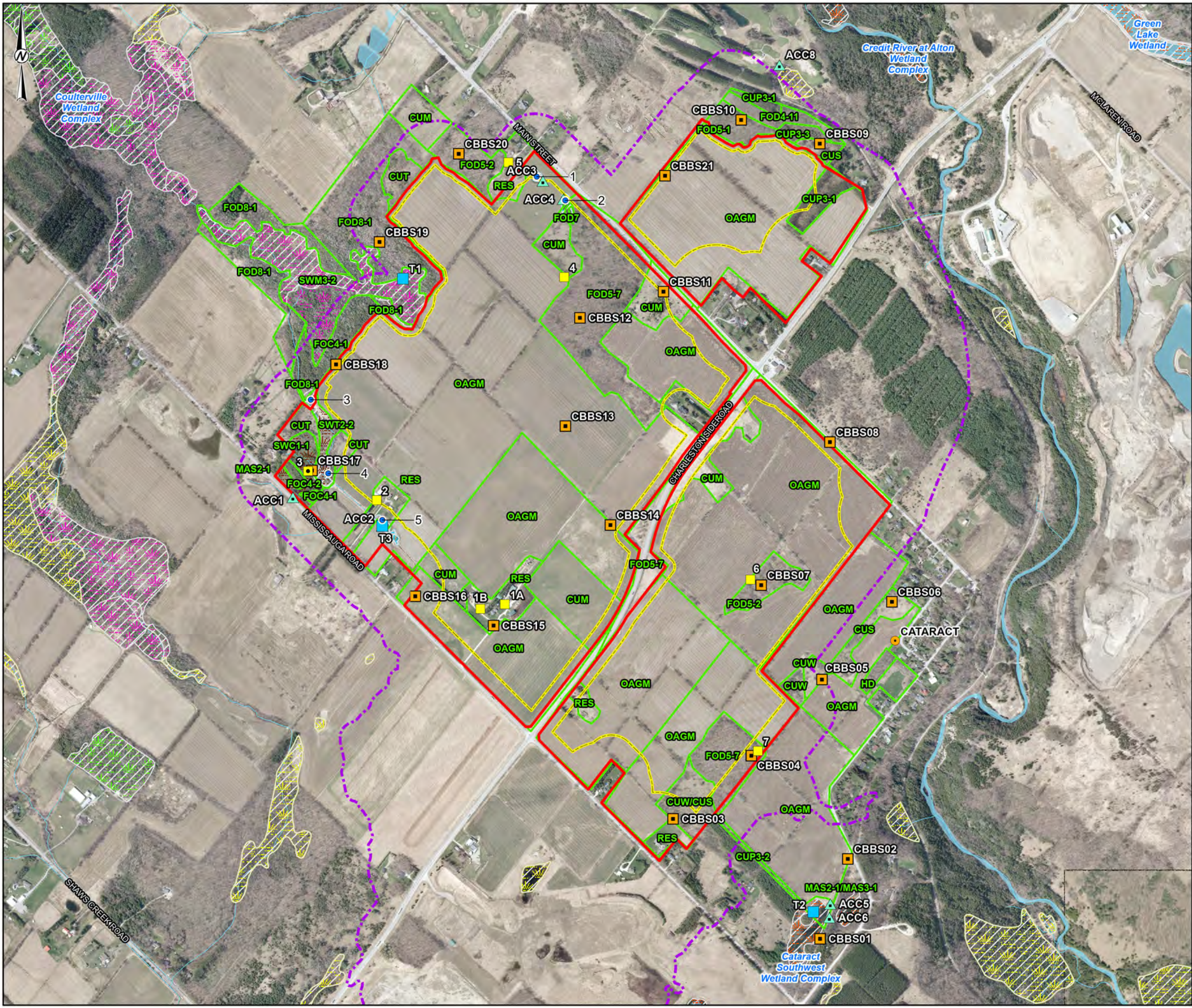
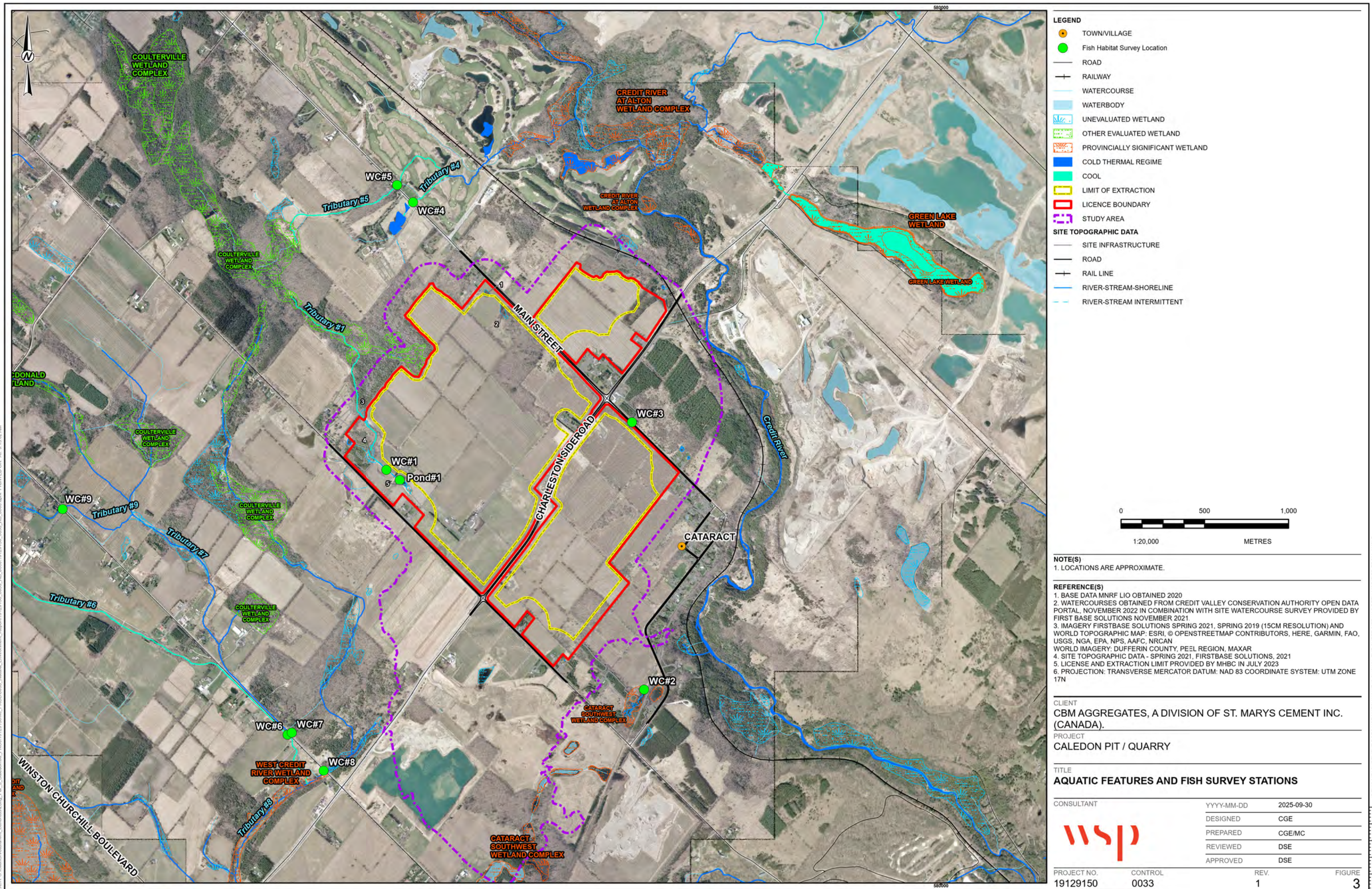

Agricultural drain with defined bed and banks. Low water level and flow velocity. Low potential for fish.

Pond is approximately 18m x 50 m and connected to the up-stream watercourse. Water level was low in the pond, resulting in no water outflowing through water control structure downstream. This resulted in the watercourse downstream of the pond being dry, and no defined channel exists downstream of the pond.
