

Notice of Adoption of Official Plan Amendment No. 5 (By-law 2025-0097)

TAKE NOTICE that the Council for The Corporation of the Town of Caledon passed By-law No. BL-2025-0097 on October 29, 2025, to adopt Official Plan Amendment No. 5 under Sections 17 of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c.P.13. This amendment pertains to an Official Plan Amendment application (File No. POPA 2024-0004) initiated by Glen Schnarr & Associates on behalf of Alloa Landowners Group to establish the Alloa Secondary Plan and to apply land use designations and policies for these lands. Please see the attached Schedules to Official Plan Amendment No. 5, attached.

The purpose and effect of this amendment is to:

- Create an overarching land-use planning policy framework to guide the development of the future Alloa community;
- Add the Alloa Secondary Plan as Chapter 36 of the Future Caledon Official Plan in accordance with the attached By-law; and,
- Amend the Official Plan schedules to add the Alloa Secondary Plan Land Use Plan as Schedule H36 to the Future Caledon Official Plan.

The basis for this By-law is contained in Staff Report 2025-0398 as received by Council on July 8, 2025.

All oral and written submission relating to the By-law were considered by Council before this decision was made.

Take notice that an appeal to the Ontario Land Tribunal in respect to all or part of this Official Plan Amendment may be made by filing a notice of appeal with the City Clerk either via the Ontario Land Tribunal e-file service (first-time users will need to register for a My Ontario Account) at <https://olt.gov.on.ca/e-file-service> by selecting **Caledon(Town) - Clerk** as the Approval Authority or by mail to 6311 Old Church Road, Caledon ON L7C 1J6, no later than **4:30 p.m. on November 19, 2025**. The filing of an appeal after 4:30 p.m., in person or electronically, will be deemed to have been received the next business day. The appeal fee of \$1,100 can be paid online through e-file or by certified cheque/money order to the Minister of Finance, Province of Ontario. If you wish to appeal to the Ontario Land Tribunal (OLT) or request a fee reduction for an appeal, forms are available from the OLT website at www.olt.gov.on.ca. If the e-file portal is down, you can submit your appeal to planning@caledon.ca.

The Town of Caledon by-law fee for submitting an appeal is \$370.00*, which can be paid by cheque made payable to The Corporation of the Town of Caledon. Please note that there is also a fee for cost recovery of preparing the appeal packages for the Ontario Land Tribunal. This portion of the fee is required to be paid upon the Town informing the appellant of such fee.

The appeal form is available from the Ontario Land Tribunal on their website at <https://olt.gov.on.ca/appeals-process/forms/> or by contacting the Town Clerk.

The proposed official plan amendment is exempt from approval by the Ministry of Municipal Affairs and Housing. The decision of the council is final if a notice of appeal is not received on or before the last day for filing a notice of appeal.

Only a specified person, a public body, registered owner of any lands to which the by-law would apply, the minister, the appropriate approval authority, or the applicant may appeal a by-law to the Ontario Land Tribunal. A notice of appeal may not be filed by an unincorporated association or group. However, a notice of appeal may be filed in the name of an individual who is a member of the association or the group on its behalf.

No person or public body shall be added as a party to the hearing of the appeal unless, before the plan was adopted, the person or public body made oral submissions at a public meeting or written submissions to the council or, in the opinion of the Ontario Land Tribunal, there are reasonable grounds to add the person or public body as a party.

A portion of the subject lands are subject to the following applications:

- Consent Applications B010-25, B011-25, B012-25;
- Zoning By-law Amendment Application RZ 2024-0031; and
- Draft Plan of Subdivision Applications 21T-24013C, 21T-24015C, 21T-24016C, 21T-25004C, 21T-25008C.
