Terms of Reference: Floor Plan Drawings

Purpose:

To illustrate the layout of structures, entrances, rooms, windows, and servicing elements on each floor
of the proposed building, including the ground floor.

Required in Support of:

- A Floor Plan may be required for the following development applications:
 - Site Plan Applications
 - DART
 - Zoning By-law Amendment Applications (where development is proposed)
 - Official Plan Amendment Applications (where development is proposed)
 - Plan of Subdivision
 - Heritage Permit Application
 - Minor Variance
 - Consent

Prepared By:

 Floor Plans must be prepared and stamped by a Registered Architect or a Professional Engineer or a BCIN (Building Code Identification Number) Designer

Content:

- General Details:
 - o Project details such as name, submission date, phasing outline
 - Applicant and owner information
 - o Legal description and municipal address (if known)
 - Drawing number and title
 - Town of Caledon issued File Number
 - Revision box and dates
 - Key map showing the location of the property, provincial, regional and municipal roads
 - North arrow



Terms of Reference: Floor Plan Drawings

- Graphic Scale bar (metric)
- o The direction of view, i.e. north, south, east, west.

Floor Plans:

- o Ground floor layout showing entrances and circulation
- Typical and non-typical floor layouts
- Interior walkways, stairs, elevators, and escalators. Note facilities to which members of the public have access from streets, open spaces, and interior walkways in adjacent buildings, where applicable.
- Location and dimensions of indoor and outdoor bicycle parking and storage facilities, as well as shower and change facilities, where required
- Existing/proposed grades on floor plan(s) that include bicycle storage and circulation
- Proposed use of spaces for each floor
- Overall dimensions
- Finished floor elevations
- Garbage/recycling storage and sorting facilities
- Show the location, dimensions and area of indoor and outdoor private and shared amenity areas, including balconies, rooftop patios, and any other publicly-accessible areas, as well as how they are accessed
- For parking structures, include dimensions, parking spaces, drive aisles, vehicular ramps, car share locations, EV charging stations, pedestrian walkways, shade structures, etc.
- Show fire control panel location/details
