A Registered Professional Planner (RPP)

Peer Review and Scoping:

• The Town may require a peer review of this document where it is required in support of aggregate applications, at the sole cost of the owner/applicant submitting the development application.

Content:

- The Town has prepared Zoning By-law Amendment templates and guides to assist planners in preparing the proposed Zoning By-law Amendment text.
 - o For a Regular (Permanent) Zoning By-law Amendment:
 - Draft Zoning By-law Amendment (text) using the Zoning By-law Amendment (Regular) template
 - For a Temporary Use By-law:
 - Draft Zoning By-law Amendment (text) using the Zoning By-law Amendment (Temporary Use) template
 - For a Zoning By-law Amendment to Remove a Holding ("H") Symbol:
 - Draft Zoning By-law Amendment (text) using the Zoning By-law Amendment (Removal of "H") template
 - For a Zoning By-law Amendment to Add a Holding ("H") Symbol, Without a New Exception Zone:
 - Draft Zoning By-law Amendment (text) using the Zoning By-law Amendment (Addition of H No New Exception) template
 - For a Zoning By-law Amendment to Add a Holding ("H") Symbol, With a New Exception Zone:
 - Draft Zoning By-law Amendment (text) using the Zoning By-law Amendment (Addition of H New Exception) template
