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The Provincial Planing Statement, 2024, and its preceding Provincial Policy Statements, have identified a Special Policy Area as being an area within a community that has historically existed in the flood plain and where site-specific policies, approved by both the Ministers of Natural Resources and Forestry and Municipal Affairs and Housing, are intended to provide for the continued wishibly of existing uses and address the significant social and economic hardships to the community that twould result from strict adherence to provincial policies concerning development. The criteria for designation and procedures for approval are established by the Province.

In recent years the Province of Ontario has asked municipalities with Special Policy Areas to update their policies and flood plain boundaries.

The draft Official Plan and Zoning By-law Amendments have been prepared along with a Planning Justification Report for the Bolton Special Policy Area Study Area. The draft amendments have been prepared concurrently with the ongoing blanto Secondary Plan Review for the areas that includes the Bolton Special Policy Area, and are not intended to conflict with or contradict the policies of Town Zoning By-law 2022-070.

The designation of a Special Policy Area, and any change or modification to the official plan policies, land use designations or boundaries applying to Special Policy Area lands, must be approved by the Ministers of Municipal Affairs and Housing and Natural Resources prior to the approval authority approving such changes or modifications.
