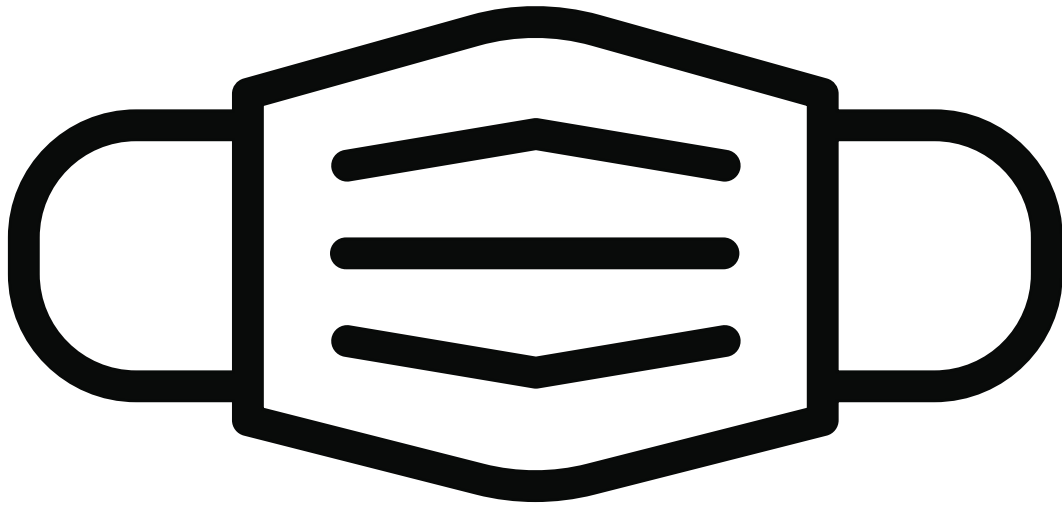

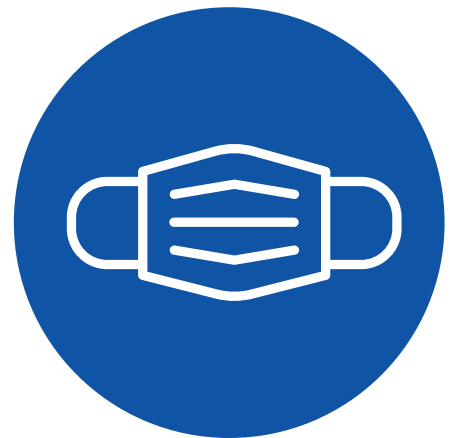
Due to COVID-19, masks are mandatory in public indoor spaces in Caledon.

Show kindness and respect. We're in this together.

- 1. If you see someone without a mask, please remember, they may be exempt.**
- 2. If you can't wear a mask, please identify yourself to the business owner.**
- 3. Business owners: exempt people do NOT have to provide proof.**

Masks are not required for:

- Children 2 years or younger
- Children between 3 and 5 who refuse to wear one
- Anyone who has trouble breathing
- Anyone who cannot wear a face covering for a medical reason
- Anyone unable to wear a face covering due to a disability
- Anyone who cannot remove a mask without assistance
- While eating or drinking in a business (e.g. restaurant)
- While receiving services (e.g. salon, barber) where removing the face covering is required
- Anyone engaged in an athletic, fitness or aquatic activity
- Police, fire or paramedics during an emergency
- Employees NOT in a public area
