Consumer Fireworks Checklist for Vendors

**** Fireworks are only to be sold 10 days prior to Victoria Day and Canada day. Please contact for inspection up to 40 days prior to event to avoid setbacks.

Caledon Fire & Emergency Services requirements for obtaining a vendor's fireworks permit

Required Documentation

- Completed application form Schedule "A"
- Payment of \$ 179.00 (including HST) via cheque, cash, VISA, MasterCard or Debit
- Provide the location of sale, municipal address
- Written authorization by the vendor or their agent
- If not the owner of the lands, provide a written authorization from the owner of the lands, indicating the consent to sale consumer fireworks
- Provide proof of liability insurance of at least 2 million dollars

Prior to Obtaining the Permit

- Contact Fire Prevention Division at (905) 584-2272 ext. 4303 or fireprevention@caledon.ca , and make arrangements for a fire safety inspection
- Ensure fire extinguishers are tagged, serviced and located as required by the Ontario Fire Code
- Ensure sprinkler heads are unobstructed and at least 18" clearance is maintained (if applicable)
- A minimum of two (2) Exits shall be provided and maintained unobstructed as per the Ontario Fire Code and The Explosives Act.
- Aisles shall be at least 1.2m wide and unobstructed
- Exit signs shall be illuminated as required
- Emergency lighting is maintained and inspected as required

***Fire Inspector will provide permit, once above requirements are met**

Post Permit

- Post fireworks permit in a conspicuous location.
- Displayed fireworks must be separated in lots not exceeding 25 kg, as outlined by the Explosives Act. **(See Consumer Fireworks Retail Package).**
- Fireworks shall be kept away from accelerants and not exposed to direct sun or excess heat.
- Fireworks not in consumer packages must be inaccessible to the public.
- Fireworks shall only be sold to individuals 18 years of age and older.
- Each lot shall be separated from other lots by means of a fire break.
- Fireworks shall be kept 8m away from sources of ignition and 3m from any vehicle parking area.
- No more than 1,000 kg of consumer fireworks being stored (including fireworks that are displayed for sale).
