



NOTES:

1. ALL COMPONENTS AND WORKMANSHIP TO CONFORM TO TOWN OF CALEDON STANDARDS No. 800, 801, 802, 803.
2. PRUNE ONLY DEAD, BROKEN OR DISEASED BRANCHES TO MAINTAIN PROPER FORM OF PLANT MATERIAL.
3. ALL TREE STAKES TO MAINTAIN MINIMUM 1.0m CLEARANCE FROM ALL POWER, TELEPHONE AND GAS ALIGNMENTS.
4. IF MINIMUM UTILITY SETBACKS PERMIT, POSITION TREE STAKES INTO DIRECTION OF PREVAILING WINDS OR IF IN BOULEVARD THAT STAKES SHOULD BE IN LINE WITH THE DIRECTION OF TRAFFIC.
5. DIG ALL ROOT HOLES BY HAND WHEN CLOSER THAN 1.0m TO POWER, TELEPHONE AND GAS ALIGNMENTS
6. ALL DIMENSIONS IN MILLIMETERS UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED.
7. DO NOT PLACE MULCH WITHIN 50mm FROM SHRUB BASE.
8. PRUNE ALL DEAD OR DAMAGED ROOTS AND BRANCHES.
9. MINIMUM SHRUB SIZE AT PLANTING TO BE 600mm HEIGHT AND SPREAD.
10. ALL PLANT MATERIAL SHALL MEET THE HORTICULTURAL STANDARDS AND PRACTICES OF THE CANADIAN NURSERY LANDSCAPE ASSOCIATION.
11. SPACING VARY DEPENDING ON SHRUB SIZE.
