

Notice of Study Commencement**

In response to continued population growth and increased wear and tear on existing infrastructure through increased traffic, development, new infrastructure, and increased expectations as to the type and quality of services the Town provides, the Town of Caledon has identified the need for improvements to Glasgow Road, from Chickadee Lane to Deer Valley Drive. Subsequently, the Town has initiated a Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (Class EA) to review and identify required road improvements along the corridor. Within the study limits, Glasgow Road will retain the existing two-lane configuration, however various options will be evaluated to enhance safety, improve traffic operations and to better accommodate road users of all types.



Key Plan

The purpose of the study is to identify recommended designs for Glasgow Road that address the increasing wear and tear associated with population growth while enhancing road safety, improving traffic operations and connectivity for all users.

In identifying the road improvements, the study will consider the technical and aesthetic requirements; as well as socio-economic, cultural heritage, and natural environment factors.

Rehabilitation of Glasgow Road is being completed as a **Schedule "A+"** project in accordance with the *Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (October 2000, amended in 2007, 2011 & 2015)*.

In response to continued population growth and increased wear and tear on existing infrastructure through increased traffic, development, new infrastructure, and increased expectations as to the type and quality of services the Town provides, the Town of Caledon has identified the need for improvements to Glasgow Road, from Chickadee Lane to Deer Valley Drive. Through subsequent review of the original study area and discussions with the Town, the study area and limits of the preliminary design have been extended to include an additional 300 m of Deer Valley Drive, from Glasgow Road to Bambi Trail, to address a missing link in the Town's active transportation network. The active transportation facility will provide better pedestrian and cyclist connectivity, enhance bicycle and pedestrian travel, and ultimately improve livability in communities.



Key Plan

The project was initiated as a Schedule A+ Municipal Class Environmental Assessment, however, has since been elevated to a Schedule “B” project in accordance with the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (October 2000, as amended in 2007, 2011 & 2015). As such, public and technical agency consultation will play a key role in developing the study recommendations. The purpose of this Schedule “B” Municipal Class Environmental Assessment is to identify the required improvements to the roadway, enhance safety, improve traffic operations, and better accommodate pedestrians and cyclists.

Through consultation with Agencies, Members of the Public, and Indigenous Communities, the preferred solution for the rehabilitation Glasgow Road is to maintain current rural roadway cross-section with addition of Active Transportation Facility (MUP) on one side. Rehabilitation of the Glasgow Road segment including pavement structure, shoulders, improved ditching and widening to accommodate a multi-use path on one side of the roadway, as well as providing a link to a new facility on one side of Deer Valley Drive.

A Project File Report (PFR) has been prepared to document the planning and decision-making process for this study. By this Notice, the PFR is being placed on the public record for a 30-day review period from November 23 to December 22, 2023. Record of Indigenous Engagement

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1.0 RECORD OF INDIGENOUS ENGAGEMENT

1.1 Summary of Events

The identification of Indigenous engagement contacts was based on knowledge about treaty areas, traditional territories and direction from the client. The following groups were contacted to determine whether they had an interest in participating in the project:

- The Department of Consultation & Accommodation (DOCA) on behalf of the Mississaugas of the Credit First Nation (MCFN);
- The Haudenosaunee Development Institute (HDI) on behalf of the Haudenosaunee Confederacy Chiefs Council (HCCC);
- The Huron-Wendat Nation (HWN); and
- The Six Nations Lands & Resources Office (SNLR) on behalf of the Six Nations of the Grand River Elected Council (SNGREC).

Archaeological Research Associates Ltd. (ARA) engaged with each of these groups over the course of the investigation. In keeping with the requirements set out in Section 7.6.2 of the 2011 *Standards and Guidelines for Consultant Archaeologists*, a description of ARA's involvement in the process is summarized below. The 2011 *Engaging Aboriginal Communities in Archaeology* draft technical bulletin was also consulted for guidance.

ARA's involvement in the engagement process began with the circulation of an invitation to participate in the project. Subsequent engagement events consisted mainly of conversations with the coordinators regarding the scheduling of fieldwork, on-site discussions with the field representatives and **the distribution of the draft report for review and comment**. A summary of engagement events appears in RoIE Table 1, and a breakdown of representative participation is presented in RoIE Table 2. It is ARA's understanding that each representative concurred with the strategies, methods and results of the investigation.
