# Architectural Control Compliance Review process



## What is the architectural control compliance review process?



A structured process to ensure that the housing product that was approved in the plans of subdivision is what is delivered to the buyers.



The Control Architect (CA) will ensure that the relevant design provisions in the Town of Caledon's Comprehensive Town-Wide Design Guidelines (TWDG) and the approved area specific Architectural Control Guidelines (ACG) are implemented through the building permit and construction stages in the plans of subdivision.



The Control Architect will do regular site inspections during the construction phase to ensure that all approved designs are implemented and provide regular updates to the Town



The TWDG and the ACG provide clear design criteria on the quality of residential building's built form, materials, roof and elevation design, fencing, porches, streetscape and more



The Town will be involved in this process for compliance review and monitor the work of the Control Architect

## Why is a Control Architect (CA) needed?

CA will review all models offered for sale and ensure that they are in compliance with the approved guidelines through to the construction stage, providing assurance to the buyers as well as to the Town




Caledon is growing rapidly; a CA will ensure that quality is not forgotten over quantity
